The Library started off with a donation of 160 volumes of books from Dr. A Majeed Khan, the founder President and President Emeritus of Independent University, Bangladesh (IUB). Located at the administrative block of the university's permanent campus at Bashundhara, the library is now housed in a floor area of 22360 square feet, with a collection of more than 27000 volumes of printed books, more than 2500000 e-books, study spaces with computers and Wi-Fi connectivity.

Resources

Following subscriptions to databases of full text electronic resources in 2002, students now have access to an extensive collection of digital and print resources - including 250000 e-books, 26000 journal titles, open access material, periodicals, 27000 printed volumes.

The library subscribes two major online electronic resources through the University Grants Commission Digital Library (UDL) and Bangladesh Academy of Sciences under the Library Consortium of Bangladesh (LiCoB), besides notable academic databases such as ProQuest-ABI Global Info, EBSCOhost eBooks Academic Collection, BDLex and Research4Life to support institutional research capacity.

IUB Archive

The IUB Archive serves as the institutional memory of the university, playing an integral role in the management of IUB's information resources in all media and formats. Inaugurated in 2016, by Dr. A Majeed Khan, the founder President of IUB, the archive collects, preserves, and makes available official records and various artifacts of IUB, including photographs,

university publications, records from various schools/departments on campus and yearbooks.

Bangabandhu and Liberation War Corner

The Bangabandhu and Liberation War Corner was established at the library with the objective to support the researchers and general readers through an extensive collection of over 2000 titles of printed books and a collection of digital videos on Bangabandhu and the Liberation War.

Online Digital Folk Music Archive

The Shaheed Khalek and Major Salek Acoustic Recording Studio (Online Digital Folk Music Archive) was set up at IUB Library by the School of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences of the university to develop a digital archive of folk music by digitizing Bangladeshi folk songs.

South Asian English Literature Corner

South Asian English Literature Corner is currently situated at level 5 of the library. Authors of these books are mainly from the South Asian Countries. IUB Library dreams to collect all available creative literary works written by the South Asian People or on South Asia.

World Religion Corner

The inauguration of World Religion Corner was held on February 23, 2021, at IUB Library to mark the National Library Day 2021 and 100 Years of Mujib. This Corner is organized to develop mental health of the users and to establishing a peaceful environment in the country. The motto of the corner is to facilitate coexistence of all religions and establish a respectful environment.

Services

Browsing Facility

The Campus is enabled with Wi-Fi; additionally, we have an E-Resource Browsing Lab having 67 net activated Computers, All PCs are dedicated for Browsing E-Resources and relevant educational purposes.

Borrowing Facility

All students, full-time faculty members and staff with valid IDs have library membership. Trustees and patrons may also access library services and resources.

Library Support for Teaching and Research

The Library provides support for students and teaching staff, through several services, to increase access to core materials and information resources. The library, specifically, helps faculty members set up customized study and research guides, while helping to populate and maintain reading lists. Staff also offer guidance and expert advice to support researchers choose discipline-specific citation styles, organize references, generate citations as well as bibliography and convert referencing styles using reference management software, to suit various publication requirements.

Workshops

The library extends its support and periodically arranges workshops on the effective utilization of library resources, re-search skills, personalization of electronic resources and the management of references using software (EndNote).

Bibliographical Services

The library personnel help researchers to check their references, in making citations, and compiling initial reading list for research.

Off- Campus/ Remote Access Services

IUB Library provides Remote Access to resources via Open Athens. Library personnel help users to open an account. Faculty members, researchers and senior students can avail of this opportunity upon request.

N.B. Remote access is permitted for the purpose of education, teaching, distance learning, private study and/or research. Any commercial use is strictly forbidden.

Discussion Rooms

There are three discussion rooms at 4th floor of the library premises. Library users can reserve any of the room for their use. The discussion rooms are usually provided for two hours. However, if there is no demand for those rooms, group members who are using can continue.

Reproduction Service

Library has one scanner to reproduce limited quantity of library materials for academic purposes only. The reproduction service is provided if it is permitted under the National and International copyright laws, rules, and regulations.

Job for Students

The IUB library regularly offers number of job opportunities as part time basis to the IUB students under the Campus Employment Program of the university. Every semester around 30 students works in the different areas of the library.

Subject Specialist Services

Subject specialists are charged with looking after the interest of specific departments, programs, institutes, or centers and available for subject specific enquiries.
